Peddagattu or Gollagattu Jathara is the festival dedicated to Lord Lingamanthulu Swamy and Goddess Chowdamma biannually. This festival makes for the second biggest religious congregation in the state of Telangana after Sammakka Saralamma Jathara in Warangal. According to history, this religious festival has been celebrated since the 16th Century.

The presiding deities, Sri Lingamanthulu Swamy, believed to be an incarnation of Lord Shiva, and his sister Chowdamma, are offered various pujas during the five-day festival. The carnival depicts the traditions and cultures of the Telangana people. Government funds are used for this celebration. There is usually police protection during this celebration, and volunteers assist during the three-day period. Devotees of all castes and religions from right across Telangana, Andhra Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Madhya Pradesh, Maharastra, Odisha, Karnataka and Tamil Nadu throng to the venue. They congregate at the temple of Lingamanthula Swamy, which is situated on a hill, located near National Highway No.65, in the village of Durajpally in the district of Suryapet.

It is primarily the Yadava community which takes part in the celebration in huge numbers. But the religious box called 'Deverapette' which contains the idols of Lord Lingamanthula Swamy and Goddess Chowdamma and many other idols, holds the key to the celebration of Durajpally Jathara. The religious box has an interesting story behind it.

According to Menthaboina Chowadaiah Yadav, elder of the local Yadava community, a family in Cheekataipalem village of Thorur mandal in Warangal district traditionally sends this box to Lingamanthula Swamy and Chowdamma temple, Durajpalli ten days ahead of the commencement of the bi-annual Peddagattu Jathara. This tradition has been followed for centuries, he said.

Days ahead of the Peddagattu Jathara, a ritual called 'Disti Puja' is performed at the temple. Then the 'Deverapette' is shifted from Chowadiah Yadav's home in Kesaram village. In the wee hours of the first day of the Jathara, the Deverapette is brought to the temple in a procession. The Deverapette contains the idols of Pothuraju, Ganga, Yelamanchamma, Akumanchamma, Pothu Lingalu and many other gods, who are worshipped in rural parts of Telangana. Interestingly, the family of Thanda Pullaiah, who are considered as priests in the Yadava community from Cheekatipalem village, located 75 km from Durajpalli, holds this box.

Since the families Menthaboina-Munna belong to the Yadava community, as also Golla Ganna Reddy their families were believed to have spotted the deities on Durajpalli hillock centuries ago. They therefore have the privilege to keep the box at their house in rotation. Families which have Menthaboina as the surname got the opportunity to keep the Deverapette at their house this year, that is, 2017.

The box has been kept at Chowdaiah Yadav's home as he is the head of the community. On the conclusion of the five-day celebration, the Deverapette will be kept at the Menthaboina family home for 18 days. After that, it will be presented to other Lingamanthula Swamy temples in Nalgonda and Warangal district.
