It is believed that the deity arose on its own in a kind of reincarnation. This temple has a very rich historic past and devotees in large numbers come to worship Lord Shiva. It was built during the glorious reign of the Kakatiya dynasty in the 12th century during the reigns of Malla Baina and Potha Baina.

Several folk tales are associated with the genesis of the 'Shivalingam' here. A cowherd saw a cow go and empty its udder over the shivalingam. The cowherd did not know that it was a shivalingam. He broke that shivalingam into eleven pieces and threw them away. But on the next day the shivalingam manifested itself as it was in the original. The cowherd explained all this to the local ruler and a temple was built around the shivalingam. The historical mystery about the shivalingam has continued to captivate the attention of the devotees. It grows one inch in height every twelve years. There is a hole at the top of the lingam and water keeps flowing through the hole in all seasons. People believe that this is Goddess Ganga. Every year, during the 'Shivarathri' festival, 'kalyanamahotsavam' is celebrated in a grand manner and also a five-day jathara (fair) is organized.
