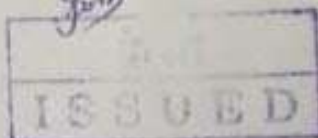

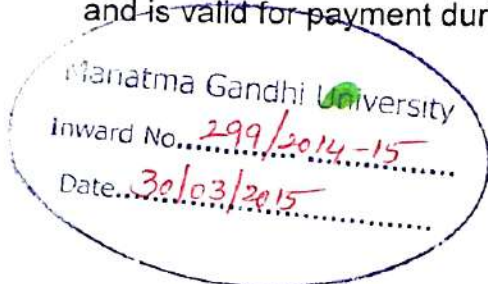

2.3 Objectives:

1. To develop patterned membrane based measurement platforms for studying dynamic processes within membrane media.
2. To understand the mechanism of ceramide production by sphingomyelinase in patterned bilayers and raft bilayers. In case of patterned bilayers.
3. To determine where exactly is cholesterol present after production ceramide by addition of methyl β -cyclodextrin.
4. Cholesterol depletion from raft bilayers would induce structural changes to the raft domain structure.
5. To establish processes for inhibition of ceramide production on addition of sphingomyelinase and also would like to understand in detail the inhibition mechanism of this process on supported membrane platform.
6. To investigate the effects of addition of various fatty acids (saturated and unsaturated fatty acids) to synthetic PC-lipid raft patterns.

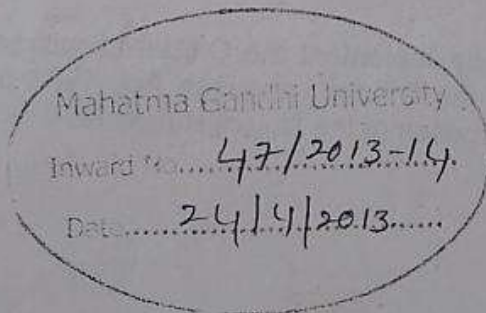
