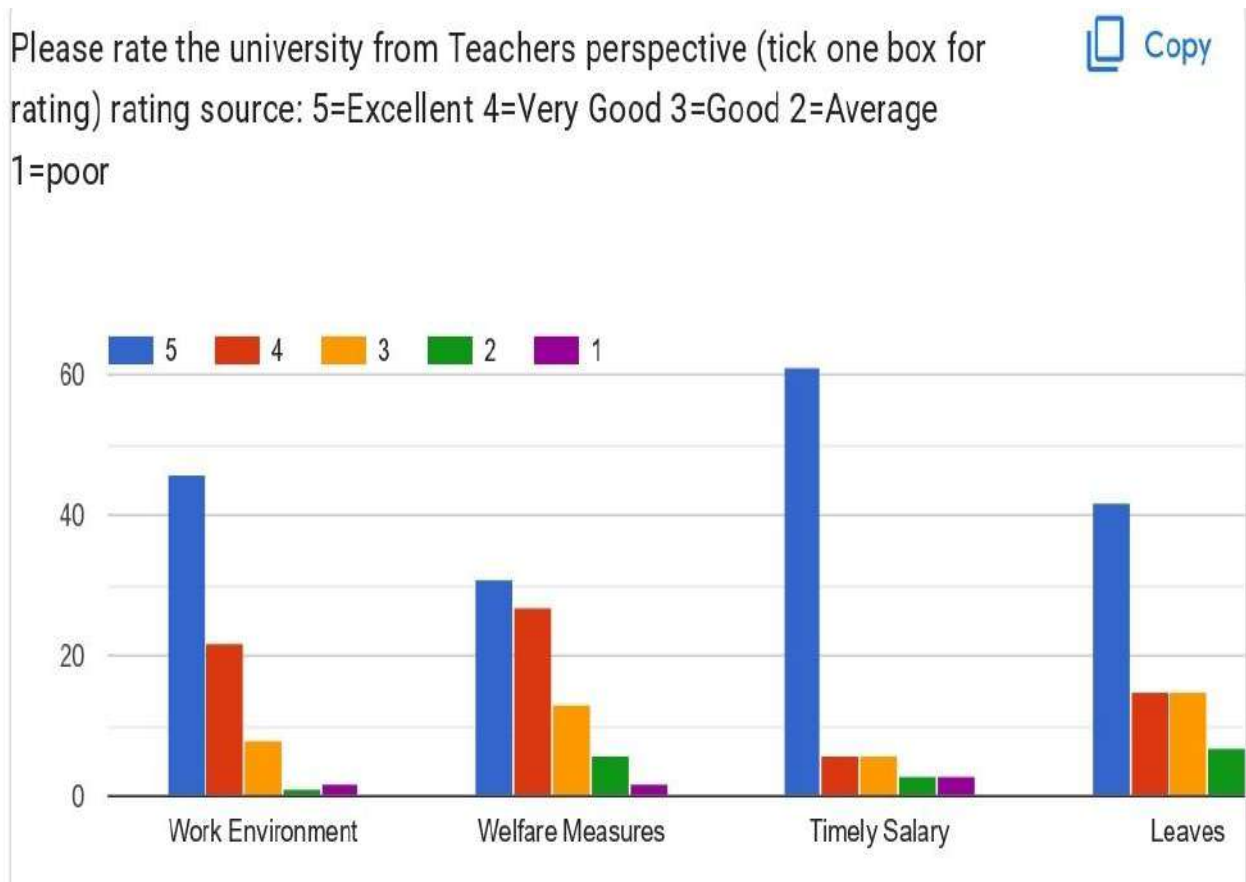

The following is the analysis of the feedback of the Teachers. 79 teachers have responded.

- Work Environment: 96 percent of the teacher respondents opine that work environment at MGU is Good;
- Welfare Measures: 90 percent of the teacher respondents said that MGU implements welfare measures;
- Timely Salary: 92 percent of the teacher respondents feel that at MGU Timely Salaries are paid;

- Leaves: 91 percent of the teacher respondents felt that sufficient leaves are granted;
- IT Facilities: 94 percent of the teacher respondents felt that IT facilities provided by MGU are good;
- Sports Facilities: 95 percent of the teacher respondents feel that the Sports Facilities at MGU are good;
- Celebration of important days / Events: 97 percent of the teacher respondents said that MGU celebrates all important days / Events;
- Medical Facilities: 82 percent of the teacher respondents said that good medical facilities are provided at MGU;
- Grievance Redressal: 86 percent of the teachers respondents opined that there is a good Grievance Redressal Mechanism at MGU.

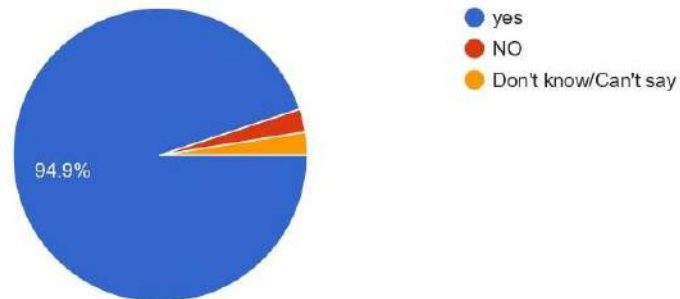

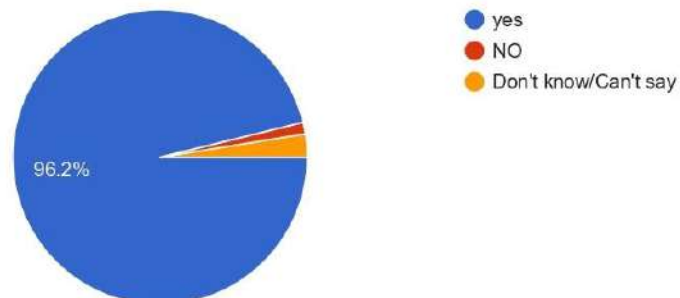

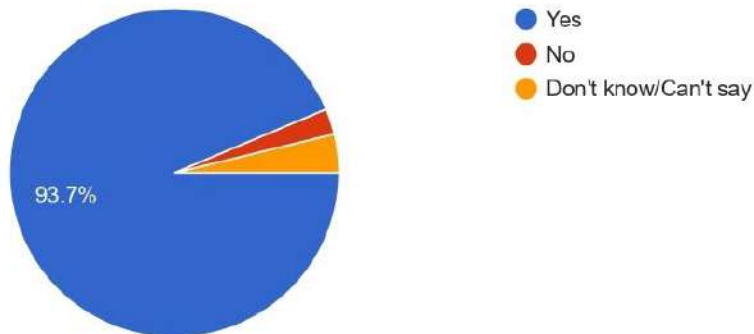

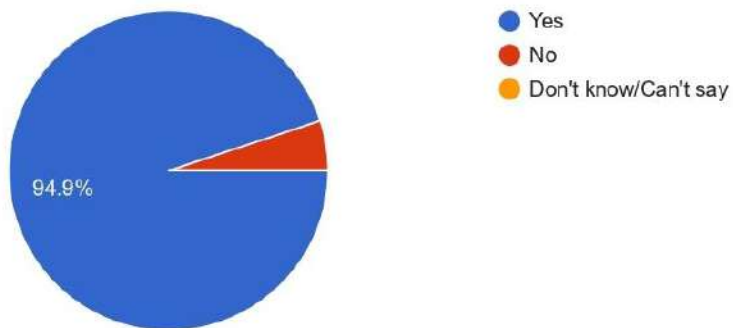

Suggestions for Improvement: The Teacher respondents have given the following suggestions for the improvement:

- Industry-Academia relations have to be improved;
- New Programmes have to be started;
- E-governance has to be implemented for ease of work;
- Plastic usage on campus has to be banned;
- Career & Placement Cell has to be strengthened;
- Research Endeavours have to be supported;
- Grievance Redressal Mechanism has to be improved;
- Improve medical facilities;
- Implement welfare measures for the teachers.

Initiatives of the University: Based on the feedback and suggestions given by the teachers, the University has initiated the following:

- The University has entered into MoUs / MoAs with CMET, TASK, Osmania University, OUTBI, ICAI, ICSI, MSN Group of Companies, SmartIMS, TechIntelli, KIMS-Narketpally, 12th Batallion, etc.
- MGU has started M.A. History & Tourism, M.A. Telugu, M.A. Development Studies and M.Sc. Botany Programmes. It has plans to start few more Programmes in the near future;
- Implementation of the E-governance is initiated;
- Usage of single use Plastic is banned on the University Campus;
- Coaching Cell for Competitive Coaching is given funds for conducting the coaching classes and the University is willing further strengthen the Career & Placement Cell;
- MGU is implementing well framed Research Promotion Policy and has plans to further strengthen the Research Endeavours;
- Online Grievance Redressal Portal is started to address the issues;
- Steps are initiated for the upgrading of the Health Centre. Further, MoUs are entered with 12th Batallion for getting the access for the Health Facilities available in their Campus and with KIMS, Narketpally for the better management of the Health Centre at MGU.
- The policy of the reimbursement to the extent of Rs.7,500/- towards the Premium paid for the Health Insurance is being implemented for the Regular Teaching / Non-teaching staff.
- The University has plans for implementing Group Health Insurance Scheme and NPS for Contract Faculty;
- The University has initiated for the formation of the Employee Credit Cooperative Society;
- The University is already implementing the ESI facility for all the outsourcing Employees.

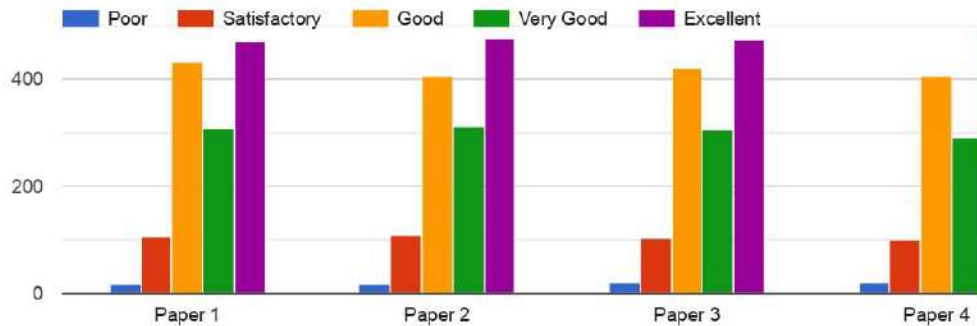
Extent of the inclusion of latest developments into the syllabus of the course

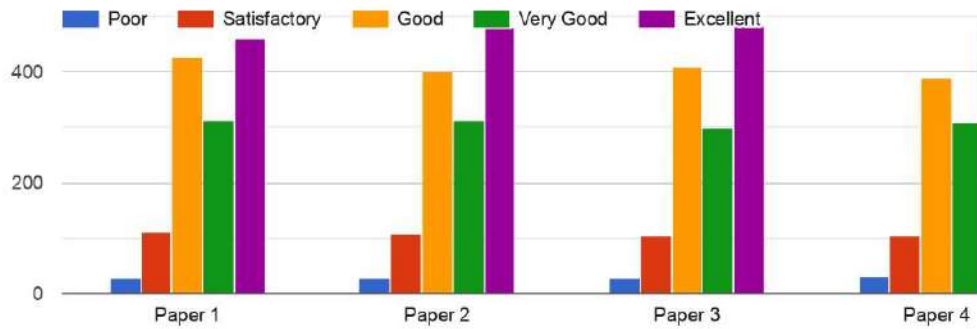
Organisation of the syllabus

13. Do you agree - Knowledge gained while at Mahatma Gandhi University, Nalgonda has helped you to become successful in your career/ profession?



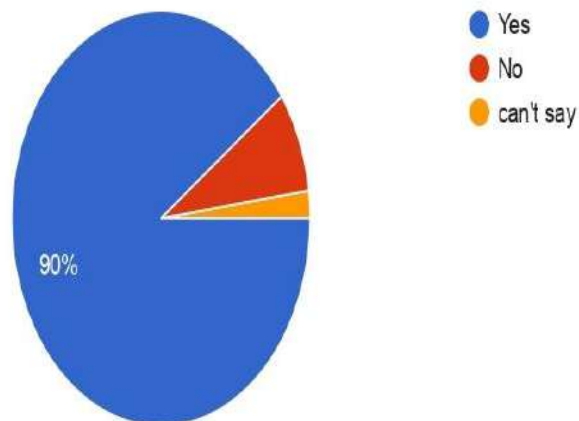

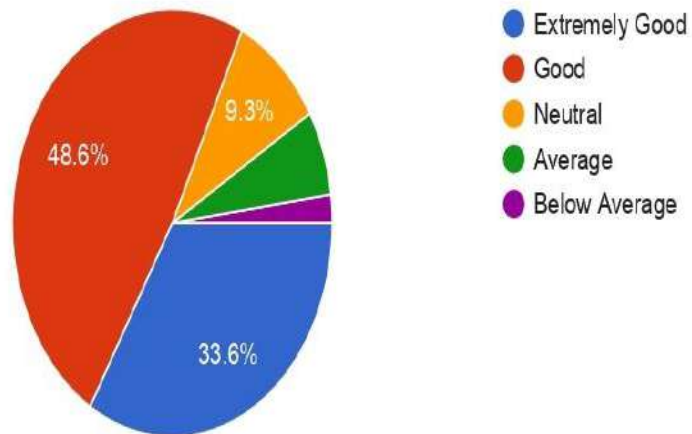
