



AND

National Association of Software and Service Companies (nasscom) having its head office at the nasscom Plots 7-10, Sector 126, Noida, UP –201303, India (hereinafter called "**nasscom/SSC nasscom**"), represented by CEO, IT-ITeS Sector Skills Council, which expression shall, where the context so admits, be deemed to include its successors, executors and administrators of the **SECOND PART**.

Whereas IT-ITeS Sector Skills Council (SSC nasscom) an integral part of nasscom is the skill standard setting body of the IT-ITeS Industry and is also the education & skill development initiative of nasscom; SSC nasscom works with its industry members and select academic and skill development institutions to help improve the quality and quantity of the employable workforce available to this industry.

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Memorandum of Understanding

This Memorandum of Understanding is entered on 15th day of February 2024 ("Effective Date") by and between Edunet Foundation having its office at A-11- 1105, Arcadia South City 2, Gurgaon 122018, India (hereinafter referred to as "Edunet"); and

Mahatma Gandhi University having its address Anneperthy, Nalgonda, 508254, Telangana hereinafter referred to as "Institution".

WHEREAS, Edunet is a non-profit organization with multiple programs, sponsored by government and corporate entities, that are offered free to learners across the education spectrum, including but not limited to the Code Unnati program;

WHEREAS, Institution is a premier institution in Telangana, India with the following details:

Established (year):	2007
Recognition, NAAC rating, ranking:	B*
Vision:	The University is committed to the course and promotion of academic excellence. The University has an agenda of tapping & developing human resources in tune with the changing times. The University also has plan to reach out to the industrial sector in and around its jurisdictional area.

AND WHEREAS, the Parties seek to collaborate with each other to mutually complement their synergies and to jointly work on building capacity of learners through one or more of the programs managed by Edunet.

NOW THEREFORE, this Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter called "MOU") witnesses the following.

- 1. Term and termination:** This MOU is valid from the Effective Date till 31st March 2027. It can be extended by further periods, as agreed to by the Parties in writing from time to time. Either Party may terminate this MOU by giving the other minimum 30 days' notice in writing. The MOU will be deemed terminated at the end of the notice period or after completing all ongoing activities so that the beneficiaries (learners and teachers) are not negatively impacted, whichever is later. Neither party will be liable to pay any compensation to the other party in respect of expiry of term or termination of this MOU.
- 2. Single Point of Contact (SPOC) for program co-ordination:** Both the Parties shall each appoint a suitable person who will serve as a single point of contact (SPOC) on all matters related to program rollout. Individual learners and teachers may be in touch with corresponding trainers, mentors, advisors, and peers during program rollout, but all matters related to the execution of this MOU shall reside with the SPOC in accordance with the terms as agreed between the parties.
- 3. Program Calendar:** The SPOCs from both Parties will work with their respective internal stakeholders to develop a calendar for the program(s) rollout at the start of every quarter. This calendar will then be synchronized and published for use by everyone.
- 4. Responsibilities of Parties:** The following table outlines the responsibilities of both Edunet and the Institution towards this collaboration.

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
