Eligibility for the participation - Students under the age of 25 years as on 20 July 2023, enrolled in a course of study at an institution recognized by any University in India shall be eligible for participating in the competition. Employees of the IA&AD shall not be eligible for participating in the completion.

The essay may be in either English or Hindi and word limit is 1500 words and it is to be submitted by email at essay2023@cag.gov.in on or before 1700 hrs of 20 August 2023. Only one entry from each participant will be considered.

Awards- The top three entries in each category (English and Hindi) will be awarded cash prizes of Rs.30,000, Rs.20,000 and Rs.15,000 for 1^{st} , 2^{nd} and 3^{rd} rank winner respectively.
