INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES APPEARING FOR THE UNIVERSITY EXAMINATIONS

- The candidate should affix a recent passport size photograph on the space provided duly attested by a Gazetted officer with date and seal.
- The candidate should also verify that the hall ticket pertains to the programme of study, and that it bears the PERMANENT REGISTRER NUMBER (PRN) of 12 digits.
- THE CANDIDATE SHOULD WRITE THE PERMANENT REGISTER NUMBER IN THE SPACE PROVIDED FOR THE SAME IN THE ANSWER BOOK. THE PERMANENT REGISTER NUMBER SHOULD ALSO BE WRITTEN IN WORDS IN THE SPACE PROVIDED. THE SPACE FOR WRITING THE SEMESTER DETAILS IN THE ANSWER BOOK SHOULD BE FILLED EXACTLY AS IN THE HALL TICKET.
- The bar code printed on the answer book should not be tampered with. Tampering bar code will be treated as malpractice in the exam.
- The candidate should write the Course Code and the name of the Course in the Answer Book as it appears in the Question Paper on each day of examination.
- Candidates should take their seats in the Examination hall at least fifteen (15) minutes before the commencement of examination. Candidates presenting themselves more than thirty (30) minutes after the appointed time will not be admitted to the examination hall. Those who are undoubtedly suffering from infectious diseases of any kind will not be admitted. Candidates should present their hall tickets to the invigilator for inspection on each day of the examination.
- Candidates are not permitted to write anything on their hall tickets or question papers other than that instructed at (3) above. They are also prohibited from writing their name, PRN or anything which would reveal their identity in any other part of the answer book. The answer books of candidates who violate this instruction will be invalidated.
- Candidates will not be allowed to leave the examination hall during the first 30 minutes after the commencement of examination.
- Candidates who do not behave properly to the Chief Assistant Superintendents/Invigilators of the Examinations or are found to have recourse to malpractice of any kind are liable to be sent out of the examination hall forthwith and will also have their examinations invalidated.
- Candidates are prohibited from bringing in to the Examination Hall any type of electronic devices other than calculators permitted for certain specific subjects. Holding / use of cell phone in the examination hall is punishable for debarring for one semester. Candidates are also warned against bringing any kind of printed matter /manuscripts from outside which would be considered malpractice at the examination hall. Such candidates are liable to be sent out of the examination hall forthwith.
- Candidates are not allowed to leave the examination hall without handing over the answer book to the invigilator.
- Violation of these instructions may involve cancellation of the concerned examination and debarring from further appearance as decided by the University.
