Eligibility:

- 1. Ph.D. Research Scholars and Young Faculty of all Social Sciences from Universities / Institutions belonging to Telangana are eligible to apply for this RMC.
- 2. The Ph.D. Research Scholars who have completed their Coursework examination / Part I and have registered for their Ph.D. from the Academic Year 2019-20 onwards are eligible to apply for this course work. The candidates must upload a PhD coursework certificate / Part-I Memo in the online application form's upload option.
- 3. The candidates who have undergone similar training courses earlier are not eligible to apply again.
